

Ogopogo Triathlon Club Levels of Infractions & Options for Consequences

<p>Level 1 Infractions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teasing • Swearing • Being disrespectful • Failing to set a positive example for younger triathletes • Failing to be a 'team player' 	<p>Level 1 Consequences</p> <p><i>1st Time</i> Prompt reminder of the Triathlete Code of Conduct Documentation by Coach</p> <p><i>2nd Time</i> Documentation and restitution by athlete (Coach will create with Athlete a condition of recognizing the wrong, fixing the wrong, and returning to the team changed)</p> <p><i>3rd Time</i> Documentation and restitution by athlete; home contact by Coach</p>
<p>Level 2 Infractions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repeat Level 1 infractions 	<p>Level 2 Consequences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prompt transfer of documentation to minimum of 2 other Coaches • Meeting held involving Coach, Parent, & Athlete <p>Suitable action taken may include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Service to the club 2. Written plan, with timeline, for the improvement of the Athlete's conduct
<p>Level 3 Infractions (Major Infractions)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Repeat Level 2 infractions • Harassment • Bullying, including all forms of electronic and cyber-bullying • Theft • Vandalism • Overt disrespect to Coach, Officials, or Volunteers • Engaging in unsafe, unsanctioned activities • Engaging in illicit or criminal behaviour 	<p>Level 3 Consequences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Documentation to be obtained and reviewed by a minimum of 3 coaches plus a parent volunteer not having an Athlete directly involved in the behaviour in question • Immediate contact with parents of Athlete involved <p>More serious action may include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Loss of privilege to participate in club activities for a defined period of time 2. Loss of privilege to participate in club activities for the remainder of the season 3. Indefinite loss of privilege to participate in club activities and loss

Guiding principle: In any circumstance, the consequence must fit the action
